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The attention of the District Vocational Education Officers of 10 districts of Telangana region is invited to the reference read above.

It is informed that various Associations of Intermediate Education Department in the meeting held on 18.10.2011 and 19.10.2011 with the Government have agreed that the period of absence of 26 days due to agitation from 13.09.2011 to 19.10.2011 will be compensated by working on holidays.

In view of the above and in order to ensure that the minimum of 226 working days prescribed for the Junior Colleges is completed the compensation for lost working days is worked out as follows:
