Sub:- A.P.I.E.S - Preservation of Earned Leave to the Principals / Junior Lecturers / Physical Directors / Librarians working in Government Junior Colleges in the State - Due to enhancement of working days from 180 to 226 days - Sanction of proportionate Earned Leave for the academic year 2013-2014 - Orders - Issued.

Government in G.O.Rt.No.421, Higher Education (IE.I) Department, dated 04.06.2001, have permitted for preservation of proportionate leave to Junior Lecturers who were prevented from availing summer vacation due to their involvement in conduct of examination, census duty and election duty and also accord sanction for preservation of proportionate Earned Leaves to the Junior Lecturers for reduction the summer vacation period due to increase of working days from 180 to 226.

In view of the Government orders cited above, all the District Vocational Education Officers and the Principals of Government Junior Colleges and Private Aided Junior Colleges in the state are permitted to preserve 10 Days of Earned Leave only for the academic year 2013-2014 due to enhancement of working days from 180 to 226 and 04 Days of Earned Leave only for the academic year 2012-2013 for involvement in conduct of I.P.A.S.E. May, 2013 and thereby preventing them from availing summer vacation, to the Principals / Junior Lecturers / Physical Directors / Librarians working in Government/ Aided Junior Colleges in the state.

The District Vocational Education Officers / Principals of Government Junior Colleges as well as Private Aided Junior Colleges in the state are requested to make necessary entries in the service registers of the incumbents to that effect.
